Welcome back! The staff and students are clearly excited to be back at school. How wonderful to see students greeting each other and initiating holiday conversations after a two week break.

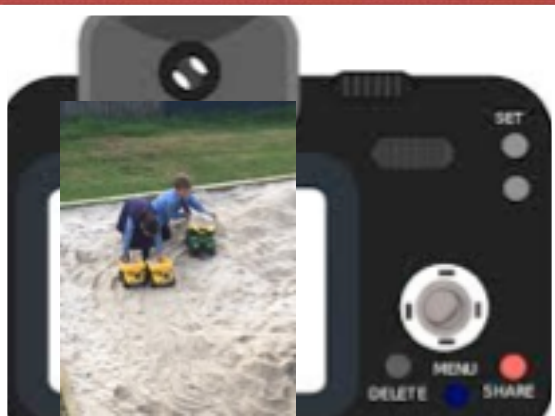

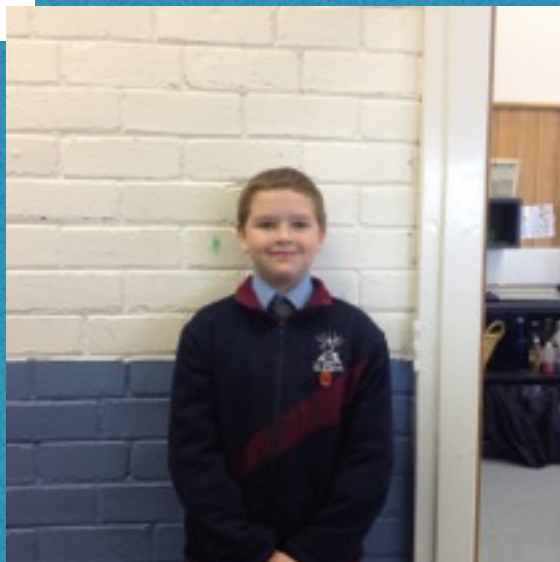
