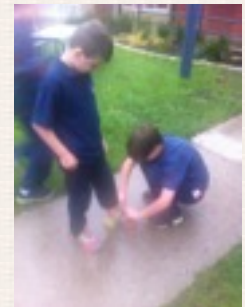

The first Pre-Kinder group on Thursday morning was held in the

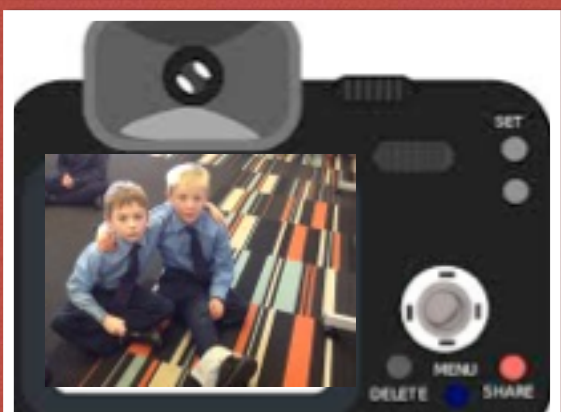
Kindergarten room and it was lovely to see so many new families begin their educational journey at St Brigid's. We look forward to building a strong, positive parent/teacher relationship.

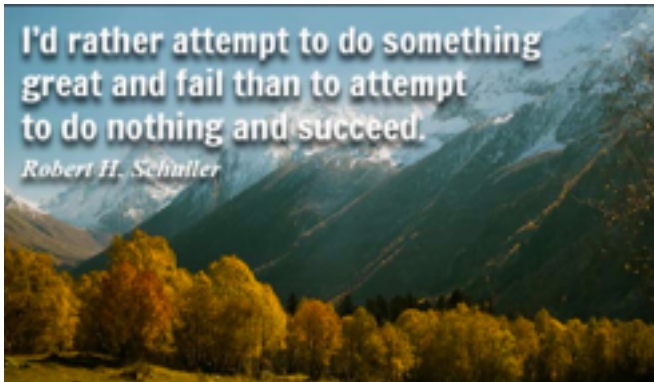
