Congratulations to the SRC who were presented with their badges at Assembly on Wednesday. Their first meeting is scheduled for Monday during lunchtime.

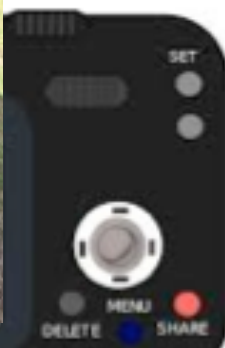
Our School Captains participated in a Grade 6 Council Leadership meeting on

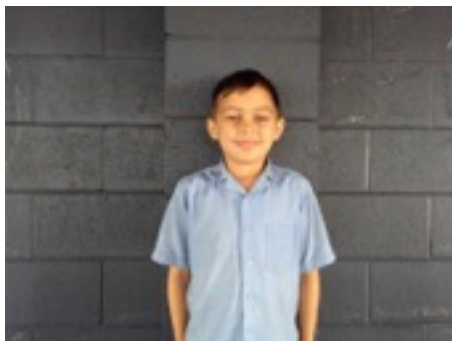
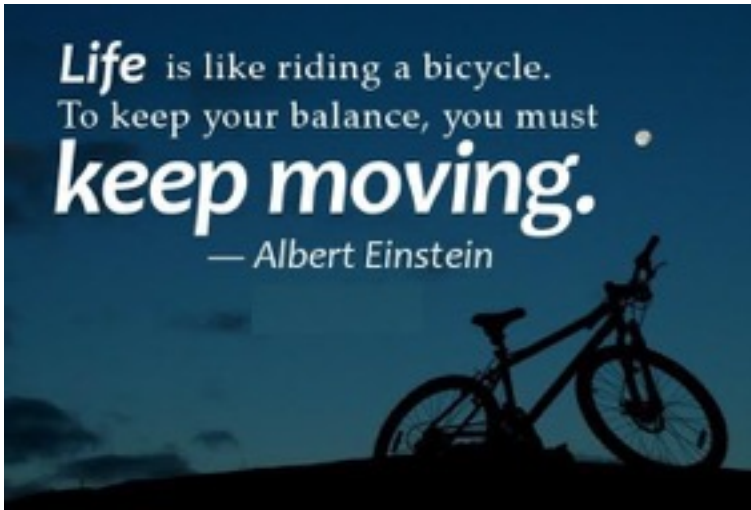

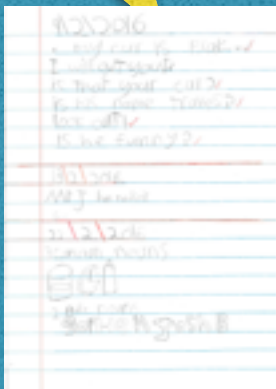
