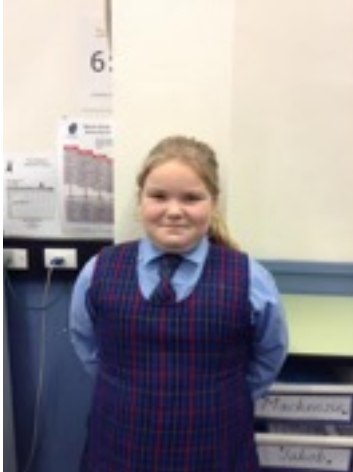

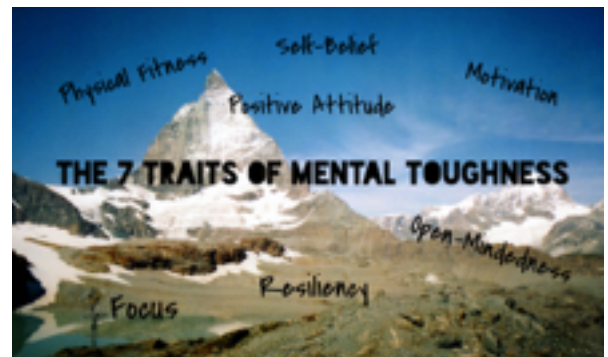
## MJR Focus : Mental toughness

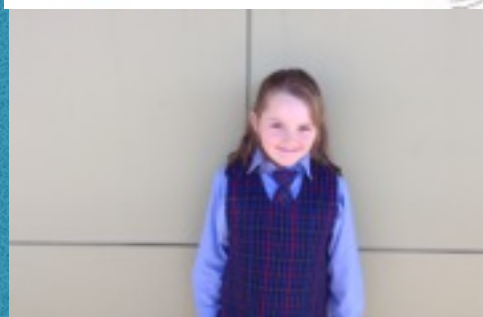


Congratulations Bella Jarvis for helping Miss Reynolds unload her teaching resources.
