dramatic and all students loved watching the performance. Their behaviour was respectful and appreciative and gave students an insight into stage production and performing in front of an audience. What an experience!

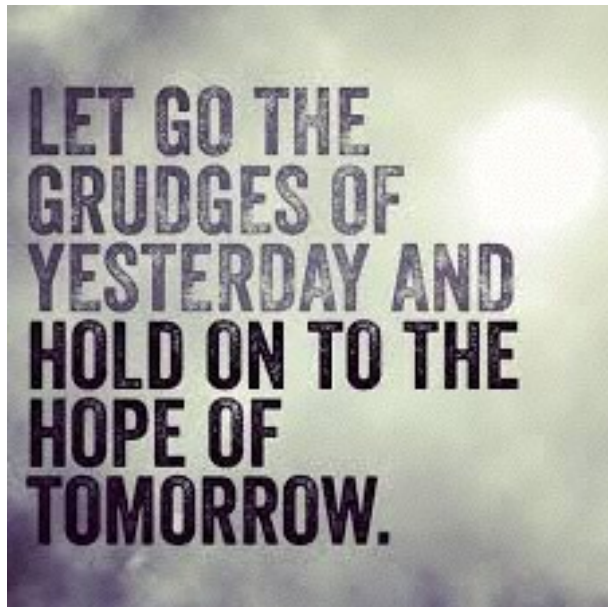

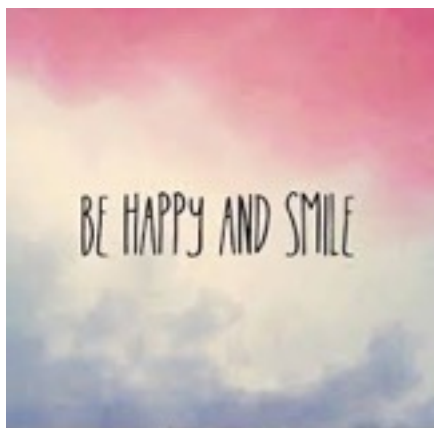
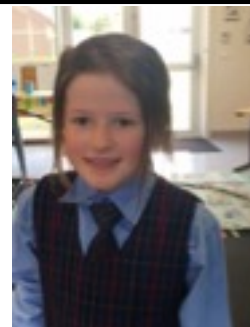


FORGIVING
