We look forward to congratulating all 'chefs' on Tuesday at Weekly Welcome.

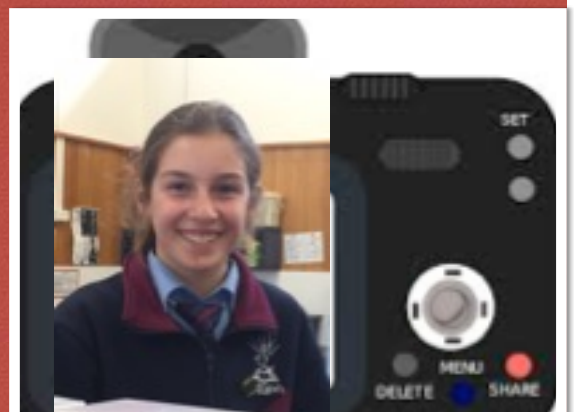

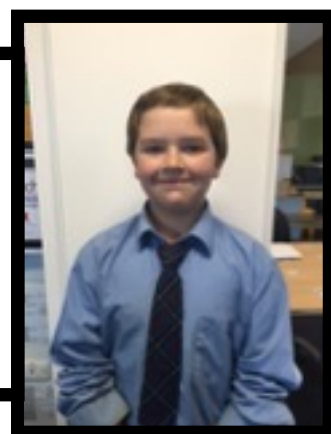
