The last couple of weeks have been very busy and in particular we've enjoyed farewelling our Grade 6 students and wish them all the best for the years ahead.

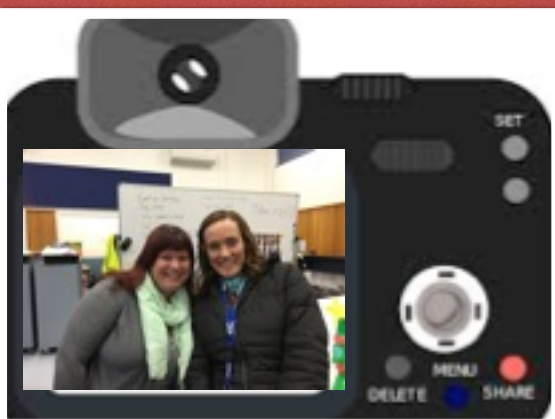
All classes have been busy preparing and rehearsing for the end of year

The end of year Picnic for Kinder - Grade 5 is exciting and we have our fingers crossed for fine warm weather.

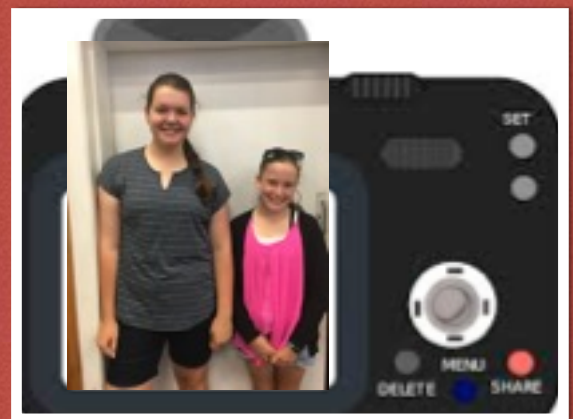
