

Brixhibition Kids Comp FAQ's

Q. How can I Enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition?

A. You can only enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition via a participating primary school or community group.

Q. Can I enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition, if I live outside of the areas below.

A. If entering the Launceston Brixhibition Lego Competition, you must live in the 63 telephone zone.

If entering the Ulverstone Brixhibition Lego Competition, you must live in the 64 telephone zone.

If entering the Hobart Brixhibition Lego Competition, you must live in the 62 telephone zone.

Entries from children living outside these areas above, or outside of Tasmania, will not be accepted.

Q. What aged children can enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition?

A. Any child from Kindergarten to Grade 6 can enter.

Q. What are the 4 age groups?

Kindergarten - Prep : Grade 1-2: Grade 3-4: Grade 5-6

Q. Can High School student participate?

A. No. The Brixhibition Lego Competition is only open to from Kindergarten to Grade 6 primary school aged students.

Q. Can I enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition more than once?

A. No. Each child can only enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition once, through your primary school or community group.

Q. Is there any cost to enter the Brixhibition Lego Competition?

A. No, Brixhibition Lego Competition is completely free to enter.

Q. Is there a Time Frame?

A. Yes, please see Terms and Conditions for your competition's time frame and completion dates.

Q. Are there any themes in the Brixhibition Lego Competition?

A. No, we invite all participating students to use their creativity and imagination.

Q. Are teams allowed?

A. No, to be fair to all students, teams are not allowed.

Q. Can I build from a Lego Kit or non-Lego branded Kit?

A. Absolutely not, we want to see original ideas and imagination in the creations.

Q. Can I build from Lego Instructions or non-Lego branded Instructions?

A. Absolutely not, we want to see original ideas and imagination in the creations.

Q. Is Duplo allowed?

A. Yes, Duplo is made by Lego, and is allowed.

Q. Are non-Lego brand bricks and pieces allowed?

A. Yes, as long as bricks and pieces are Lego Compatible.

Q. Are moving parts motors, and lights allowed?

A. Yes, however the batteries may not last running over the 2 day weekend, if your winning entry is invited to the Brixhibition event.

Q. What is the maximum size creation allowed?

A. Each Lego creation is not to be larger than 52cm Wide , 52cm Deep, 52cm High or no larger than four 32x32 lug Lego baseplates. (two baseboards wide x two baseboards deep)
All parts to the Lego creation **MUST** stay within these dimensions.

Q. What are age group winners?

A. Each School or Community Centre will pick a winner from your each of the age groups. (If they run age groups).

Q. What is the overall winner?

A. Each School or Community Centre will pick 1 overall winner (from your age group winners).
The overall winner will represent your primary school or community centre and be invited to display their winning Lego creation at the Brixhibition event, and participate in the Brixhibition Grand Prize competition.

Q. Can I build my Lego Creation at School or at Home?

A. Yes, you can Build Lego Creation anywhere.

Q. What are the Local primary school or community groups prizes?

A. Age Group Winners

Each age group winner will win an Age Group Winners Medallion and free passes to:
Richmond Gaol, Leven River Cruises and Beaconsfield Heritage Museum.

A. Overall Winner

Your overall winner at your primary school or community group will win a special Overall and Age Group Medallion, and free passes to: Richmond Gaol, Leven River Cruises, Beaconsfield Heritage Museum and possibly an extra surprise prize.

Q. What are the grand prizes?

A. The Brixhibition Grand Prize Winners

1st Place – A Trophy and a \$300 Lego Voucher

2nd Place – A Trophy and a \$200 Lego Voucher

3rd Place – A Trophy and a \$100 Lego Voucher

4th Place – A Trophy

Q. School can provide other prizes if they want?

A. Yes, your school or community centre can give out extra prizes if they choose to.

Q. If I'm picked to be the overall winner from my school or community group, then what?

The Overall Winners Parent/Guardian will be asked to fill in and sign an Entry/Permission form.

(The competitions organiser from your school or community group will provide this).

After the fully completed and signed Entry/Permission form is returned back to the Brixhibition Competitors co-ordinators, then you will be contacted directly by phone, to arrange drop-off and pickup of the winning Lego creation to and from the Brixhibition Event. (or to make alternative arrangements)
